Crabbing 101: Do you want to learn and experience the fun of crabbing in the Lowcountry? Come on down to the Learning Center where one of our naturalists will show you everything there is to know about crabbing! **Pre-registration required. \$5 per person. (30-45 minutes)**

Crabby Critters: What do a fiddler, a ghost, and a stone have in common? They are all types of crabs! Edisto is home to many different types of crabby critters which are very important to our coastal ecosystem. Join us as we take a closer look at some of our crabby friends. **Free with Park Admission. (30-45 minutes)**

Gators of the Lowcountry: Learn more about South Carolina's largest reptiles and these modernday dinosaurs during this educational program. Also get an up-close look at our resident gators, Pebbles and Bamm-Bamm! Pre-registration required. Free with Park Admission. (30-45 minutes)
