Birds of Edisto: Come learn about some of our resident birds in this avian-based trivia game. No binoculars needed. Pre-registration required. Free with Park Admission. (45 minutes-1 hour)

Edisto is home to many different types of crabby critters which are very important to our coastal ecosystem. Join us as we take a closer look at some of our crabby friends. **Pre-registration required. Free with Park Admission. (30-45 minutes)**

Gators of the Lowcountry: Learn more about South Carolina's largest reptiles and these modern-day dinosaurs during this educational program. Also get an up-close look at one of our resident gators! Pre-registration required. Free with Park Admission. (30-45 minutes)
